

Oak Valley Health declares outbreak of COVID-19 at the Reactivation Care Centre

December 7, 2023

Today, in consultation with Toronto Public Health, an outbreak has been declared at Oak Valley Health's Reactivation Care Centre, unit 5W.

An outbreak as defined by the Ministry of Health, is two or more laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 cases (patients and/or staff) with a common epidemiological link within a specified area (unit/floor/service) within a seven-day period where both cases could have reasonably acquired their infection in the hospital.

Two patients have tested positive. The two patients remain in hospital and are on Additional Precautions and are being monitored closely.

As per outbreak management measures, heightened infection prevention and control measures have been implemented such as testing of patients, close monitoring of patient symptoms, enhanced cleaning of the department and equipment, and ongoing auditing and reinforcement of personal protective equipment (PPE) practices.

The health and safety of our patients, the community, and our health care workers is paramount. The Infection Prevention and Control and Occupational Health & Safety teams at Oak Valley Health are working closely with Toronto Public Health to ensure that best practice guidance is undertaken.
